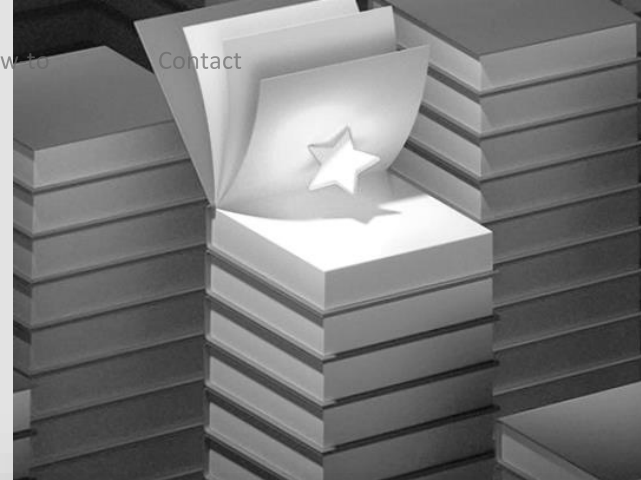

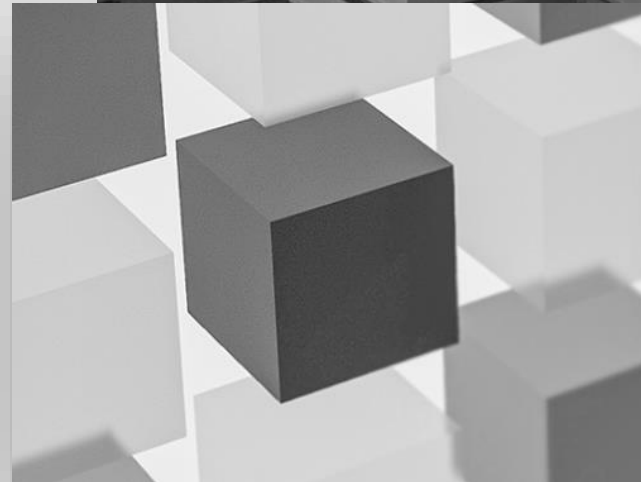


Early Warning System
